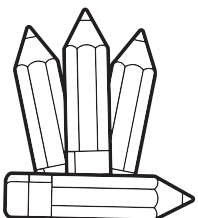


The Campbeltown Mermaid

This Mermaid appears at the very top of Campbeltown cross. She has sat watching over the town since the cross was brought to Campbeltown over 300 years ago, but she may be nearly 600 years old herself. Although we cannot be certain what she looked like, in October 1811 a local farmer called John Mclsaac claims to have seen a mermaid close to the shore near Campbeltown at a place call Corphin. The creature had long flowing hair, a lower half covered in scales and a tail 12-14 inches wide.
